




#GEMAB23 | Higher together! What is the #GEMAB?

Is it a show, a competition, a cultural and tourist event, an economic convention? Maybe a little bit of all this at the same time, but above all a great festival of fraternity that allows each practice hot air ballooning. In the heart of the 3 major components of the Grand Est Region which are Alsace, Champagne-Ardenne and Lorraine, on a former American base rehabilitated into an airfield. To organize two daily mass flights, to offer a range of activities related to aeronautics, to propose a panel of activities related to aeronautics, to erect 3 villages (pilot, partner and public) along the flight area in order to welcome thousands of spectators from all over the world.

It's a celebration of the big multicolored bubbles invented 240 years ago, which continue to light up the sky and to fascinate the humans.





#GEMAB23 | Higher together! 240 years of the first human flight

In 1983, for the bicentenary of the first human flight, we created the Pilâtre de Rozier Challenge in Metz (Moselle). What could be more normal than to recall that the birth of Pilâtre de Rozier in Metz led to the creation of a perennial activity which continues nearly 40 years later.

Today, Pilâtre de Rozier Organisation has an AeroMuseum on the history of hot-air ballooning and the Chambley base in the American era, a pilot training center, manages a fleet of hot-air balloons with a maintenance workshop. And every year the company participates in the teaching of the Brevet d'Initiation Aéronautique and welcomes nearly a thousand children for educational workshops.

Conferences will be proposed in the AeroMuseum to recall the birth of hot-air balloons and gas balloons.





#GEMAB23 | Higher together! The Chambley airfield

Among all the aeronautical platforms on the territory, many were created by the French, but also by the Americans and the Canadians, during the Cold War era. Some of them are only memories in the history books, others like Chambley have survived and have become places where aviation is practiced in the 21st century.

The Chambley airfield was created during World War II and developed by the Americans from 1954 to 1967. Michael Collins (Apollo XI) commanded a fighter squadron there and married. Owned by the Grand Est region of France, Chambley airfield is today a very highlevel platform in aeronautics which welcomes 25,000 movements per year. It is also an important place for aeronautical training.






The meeting place of nations

Since 1989, the will of the organizers has always been to gather the planet. Of course, it is difficult to gather all the countries which practice aerostation, but the objective to exceed fifty nations at each edition is the leitmotif. Not to be famous for any record, but to give the possibility to all the pilots to meet each other and to make the visitors live an exceptional show of mass take-offs.

If the Europeans are present in mass, the more distant countries like the United States, Brazil, Taiwan, South Africa and Canada are represented. After the period of the pandemic, the #GEMAB23 will be the opportunity to find the crowd of the great days.

Between the morning and evening flights, what can we do on the Chambley site?

There are many animations, stands and presentations related to the world of aeronautics.

In the air:

• First flights in a hot air balloon, plane, Ulm, glider, para-ascensional

On the ground:

- Visit of the AeroMuseum + aerial photography museum
- Virtual flight in a hot air balloon
- Conferences on hot air balloons and gas balloons

Four villages around the airfield

Around the take-off area (about 250 ha), there are three main villages of canvas and hangars. These villages are called the pilot, public and partner BalloonCity. The 4th village is the one of the organization.

It takes a month to set up these villages which will welcome thousands of people. Everything is planned 24 hours a day for these BalloonCities.

A school of life

Among the assets of the #GEMAB, it should be noted that the organization welcomes nearly 200 volunteers from 11 nations.

These volunteers, most of whom are under 21 years of age, have the opportunity to participate in an international event by working as greeters, information officers, organizers and supervisors. Among them, about thirty high school students from the Grand Est Region are invited to join the team at each edition.
